Username: your student number

password: your date of birth (**DDMMYY**)

For Example:

- Username: 2020201
- Password: 040100 (if your date of birth is 4th January 2000)

You will be asked to change your password after your first log in to [eVision](#).

Please keep this password safe and remember it because you will need this same password to log in to all other accounts.


2. Brightspace

You will be asked to change your eVision password (date of birth in DDMYY format) after your first successful login.

1. If you forget this new password **before** you complete your registration, please contact Student.Centre@Brunel.ac.uk to reset it for you back to your date of birth.

2. If you forget your password **after** you complete your registration, you can either:

– Go to [Brunel Self-Service Password Reset](#) then to enter your username as **academic\username**

or

– Log in to a Brunel centrally managed computer; press the **ctrl + alt + del** keys together and select Change a password.

Password Policy

Choose a secure password which contains:

- . At least 14 characters
- . Uppercase letters (A F T X etc.)
- . Lowercase letters (g j r q etc.)
- . Numbers (4 7 8 3 etc.)

Password Good Practice

- Use a password that is difficult to guess but easy for you to remember, so you do not have to write it down;
- Use a password that you can type quickly, without having to look at the keyboard, thereby preventing passers-by seeing what you are typing;
- Use a Passphrase, it is more secure as it is a sequence of words

How do I protect my password?

- **Never tell anybody** your password (not even Computer Centre staff), nor send it via e-mail
- **Be wary of messages** which look like this one: **never** click any links or open any attachments
- **If a website does not start `https://`** (check it every time, and **never** assume), it means the website is not secure enough to enter any password or similar credentials (credit card number, etc.) - **so don't do it!**
