PG Cert Intelligence Analysis	The tuition fee includes the cost of a residential element costing £1260.
MA Intelligence and Security Studies (Distance Learning)	The tuition fee includes £1260 for a 1 week residential element in year 1 (there will be a second residential element in year 2 which will again be incorporated into the tuition fee).
PGCE (all programmes)	<p>Travel costs to placement schools can vary considerably with personal circumstances, including where student teachers live. The highest travel cost seen during the last academic year was as high as £30 per day for a student living a long way out of our partnership area; for most students it is considerably less. There are a minimum of 120 placement days in the course, commonly it is closer to 125. The monthly training bursary, for students in receipt of it, is intended to offset the cost of these out-of-pocket expenses.</p> <p><i>Enhanced DBS check:</i> Home fee paying students - £51.86 plus an additional £11 if the ID check is carried out at a Post Office.
