

Guide to the 40% first payment required at Registration

For full time Undergraduate, Postgraduate Taught and Research degrees commencing in 2022/3 or 2023/4

Overseas fee-paying students joining degree programmes at Brunel University London are required to make a first payment of at least 40% of their first-year tuition fee in order to register on their course with Brunel University London. If this applies to you, you will be told in the communications you receive from Admissions.

If you are unsure of how much this first payment might be, please refer to the table below which contains the main Overseas fees for our Undergraduate, Postgraduate Taught and Research degree programmes.

- 1. In the first column of the table, locate the tuition fee that is quoted in your Offer email.
- 2. In the second column you will find 40% of that fee.

Important: The fees quoted in this table do <u>not</u> take account of any discounts or scholarships that you may be eligible for. All discounts and scholarships are applied at registration, and so your fully-calculated tuition fee, and consequently your 40% first payment, may be lower. Your fully calculated fees and 40% payment, with any discounts or scholarships deducted, will be presented to you in your online registration task when you come to register on your programme.
