Council Ordinance 12

Pro-Chancellors

1.1 There shall be up to three Pro-Chancellors appointed by Council on behalf of the University.

1.2 In the absence of the Chancellor, or during a vacancy in that office, Council will determine whether one of the Pro-Chancellors shall act in place of the Chancellor.

1.3 Council shall require Nominations Committee to oversee the process for selecting successor Pro-Chancellors and to recommend to Council candidates for appointment. Nominations Committee shall also, if appropriate, recommend to Council the appointment of a person to serve as Acting Pro-Chancellor.

1.4 The process of appointing Pro-Chancellors shall be prescribed in the Ordinances.

1.5 Pro-Chancellors shall normally be appointed for a period of up to five years or until resignation or removal in accordance with Ordinance 13, Article 1.8 and unless so removed shall be eligible for re-appointment on one further occasion for a period of up to five years (as determined by the Council).
