Academic Word: distinct (adj) /dɪ'stɪŋkt/

Meaning: clearly different from something else

Collocations: 'clearly distinct'
'totally distinct'
'distinct from something...'

Examples: A distinct difference was found in the second set of results.



**General English Expression:
'call it a day'**

Meaning: agree to stop doing something

Example: "We've been working for hours!
I'm really tired."

"Yes, I agree. Let's call it a day and go home now."

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
