Academic Word: community (n) /kəˈmjuː.nə.ti/

Meaning: the people who live in a particular area,

or a group of people who are

considered as a unit because of their

shared interests or background

Collocations: 'local community'

'academic community'

'to be part of a community'



Examples:

There is a strong sense of community at Brunel University London as all

departments are based on the single campus.
