

### Apply for <u>accommodation</u> on campus

You can apply for accommodation at Brunel as soon as you've received an offer, but you won't be able to book anything until your offer becomes unconditional. No need to worry though, all international students are guaranteed on campus accommodation at Brunel

throughout their degree!



You'll need to meet the conditions by the deadline given in your offer email before we can issue you with a CAS number (you need this for your Visa application). These may include:

- Uploading evidence of the qualifications you have completed on <u>MyApplications portal</u>
   Applying for your <u>ATAS certificate</u> and uploading a copy to <u>MyApplications portal</u> (only required for some courses)
- Completing a Length of Study form
- Paying your course deposit

### Book your accommodation

Once your offer has been made unconditional, you can select your accommodation and pay the deposit. Find out more about our <u>on-campus accommodation</u>.

### Apply for a Visa You'll need a <u>Tier 4 (general)</u>

Student Visa to study in the UK. Once you've met all the conditions of your offer, we will provide you with a CAS number which you can use to apply for your Visa. Please note, we can only issue this three months before your course starts.
