Undergraduate Scholarships for Mechanical Engineering Students



IMechE Undergraduate Scholarships

- Are you expecting to commence your IMechE accredited degree programme in the next academic session?
- Are you studying A-Levels, Highers/Advanced Highers, International Baccalaureates, or equivalent qualifications and expecting excellent results?
- Have you received an offer of a place on an IMechE accredited full-time degree programme to commence in September/October?
- Are you expecting to gain 340 points or above, in a maximum of 4 different science related subjects, with A or B Grades, (up to 2 of these may be AS levels, which must be A Grades), excluding General Studies?
- Are you resident in the UK?

Then you may be eligible for an award of £4,000 (Usually £1,000 over four years). The award is for a maximum of four years (excluding industrial years).

IMechE Undergraduate Scholarships are offered annually to encourage outstanding students to undertake the study of mechanical engineering to professional level.

Applications are being sought only for students who will commence their studies at University in September/October this academic year. Gap year students should defer application until the year of the commencement of their degree.

Please note that particular attention should be given to answering question 8 on the application form, as this will form part of the selection process in selecting applicants.

Interviews are mandatory, and shortlisted candidates will be notified at the beginning of September if they are required to attend an interview. Unfortunately, if a candidate is not able to attend an interview on the specified date (normally during September), then an alternative date cannot be arranged. For the dates of interviews, please contact the Prizes and Awards Department.
