

SENATE REGULATION 9: Honorary and Visiting Academic Appointments

Appointment of Honorary and Visiting Staff

- **1.** The University may make Honorary appointments to individuals who have experience relevant to its work and are in a position to make a positive contribution to this. Appointments are normally for three years, but may be renewed.
- 2. The University may appoint individuals spending a short period of time, normally up to one calendar year, at the University to participate in teaching or research activities as Visiting academics.
- **3.** Council Ordinance 9 confirms that Senate is responsible for appointing Honorary Professors, Readers, Senior Lecturers and Lecturers, and may revoke such appointments where there is good reason to do so.
- **4.** Honorary Professors are appointed by the Provost on the recommendation of the relevant Vice-Provost and Dean of College or the Director of BCAST. All other Honorary or Visiting appointments are made by the relevant Vice-Provost and Dean of College or Institute Director on the recommendation of the relevant Head of Department. All appointments are reported to Senate annually.
- **5.** Further guidance on these appointments is produced by Senate.
- **6.** Honorary or Visiting appointments are unpaid and do not include a contract for services. If agreed by the relevant Vice-Provost and Dean of College (or nominee) or the Director of BCAST, and the Director of Human Resources (or nominee), an honorarium may be paid.
