Applications are invited for the above permanent, full-time post based at the Uxbridge Campus. In particular this will involve installation, maintenance and monitoring of the local Unix clusters at Brunel and RHUL. The postholder will also be responsible for supporting other clusters based in the School of Engineering and Design at Brunel, and for providing general research support where appropriate.

The ideal candidate will be of graduate calibre with substantial relevant experience within a computing support environment, ideally within Higher Education sector. Knowledge of Linux and Solaris, and of installing and working with clusters is also essential. Regular travel to Royal Holloway will be a requirement for this post.
