



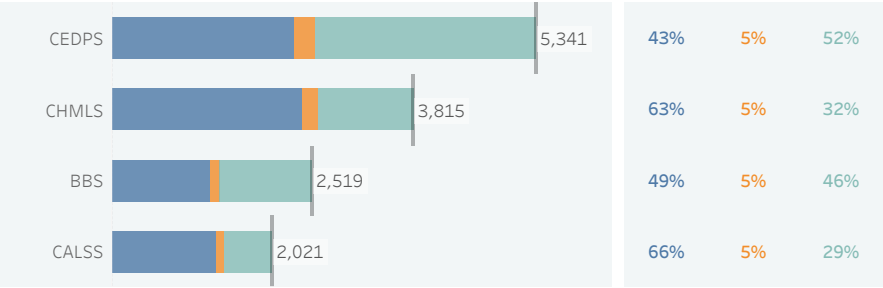

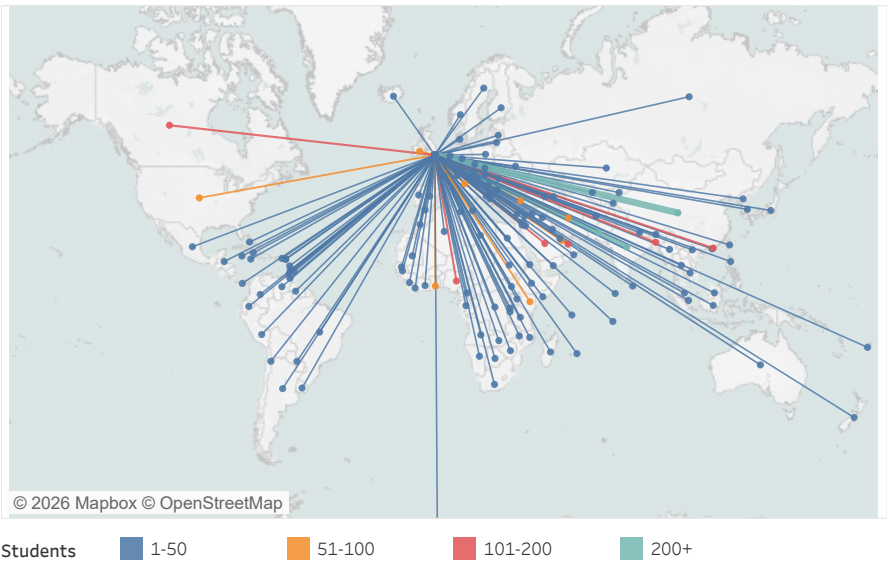

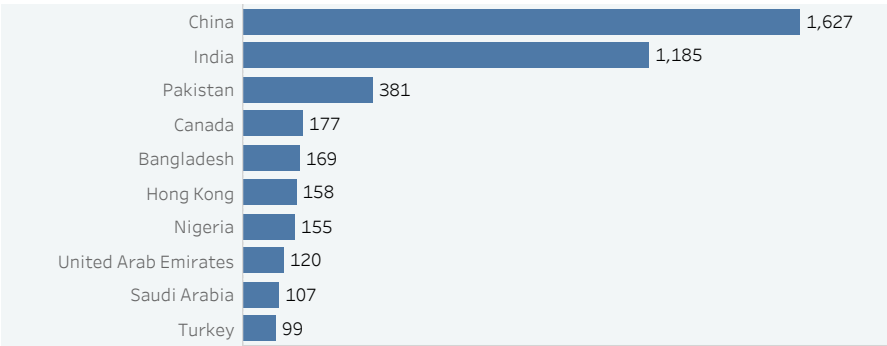

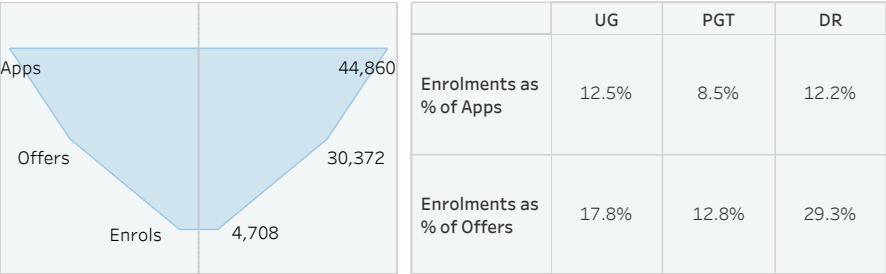

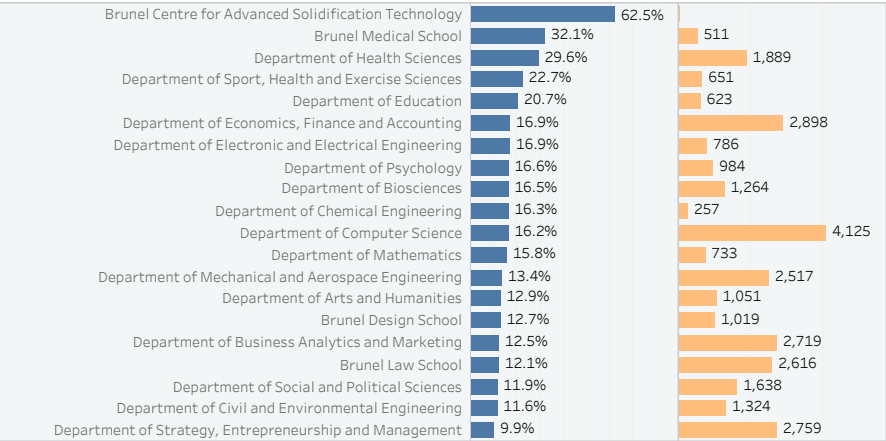
Application to enrolment funnel

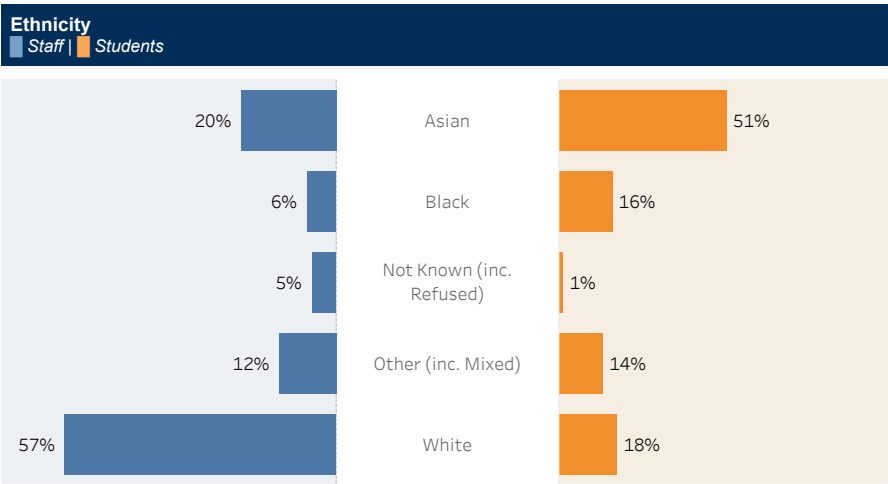
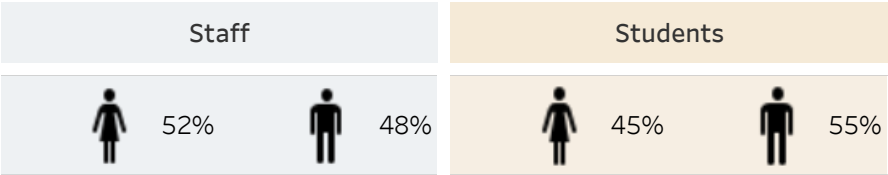


Enrolments as a proportion of offers by Department

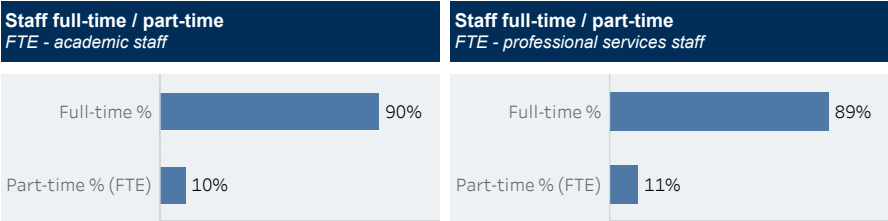
Enrolment % | Offers

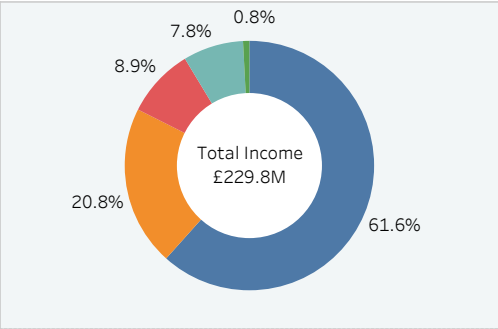

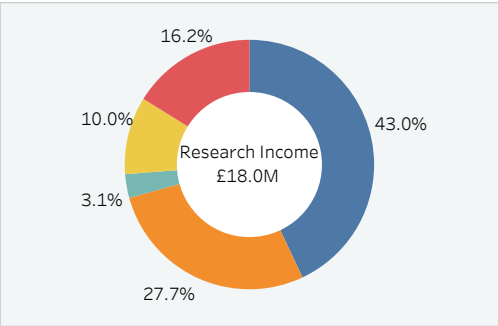


Financial Position 2024-25

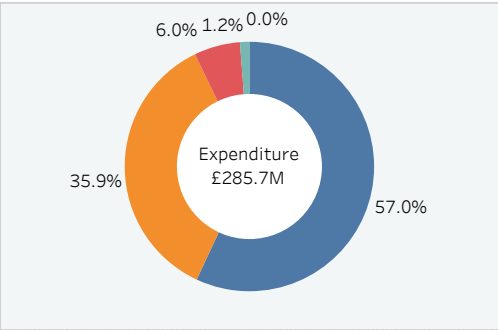

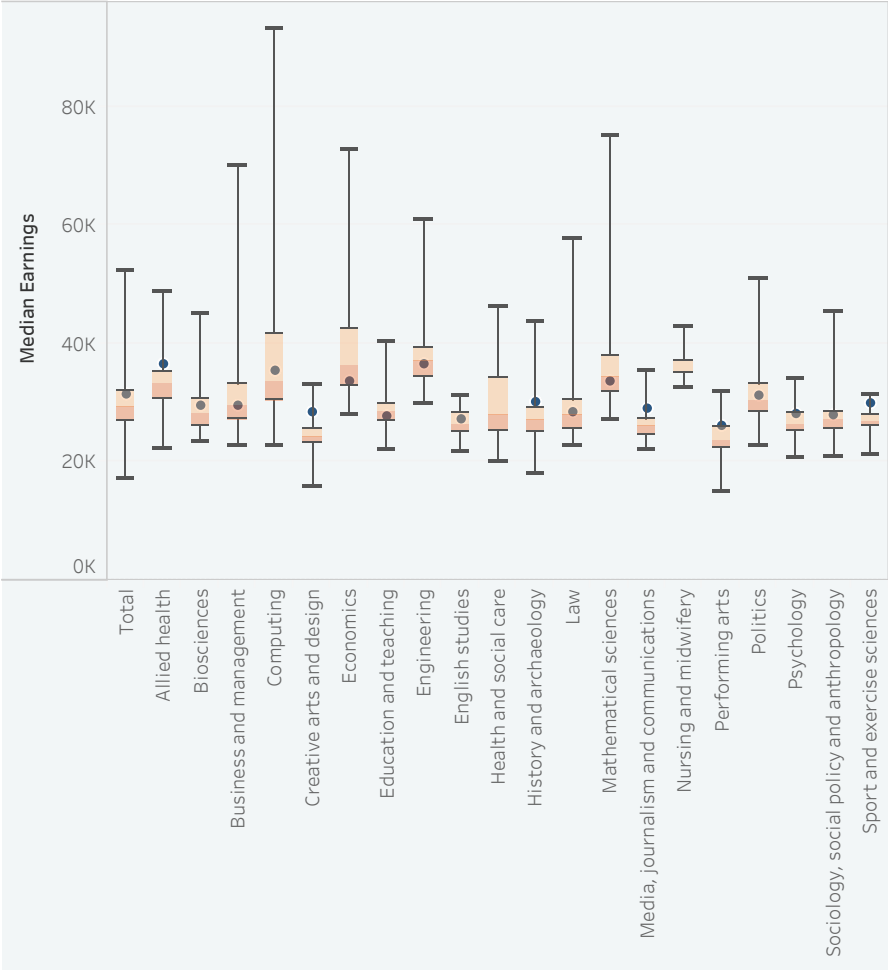
