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GUIDANCE FOR COMPLETING PROGRAMME SPECIFICATIONS

These notes are designed to assist you in completing the programme specification proforma.

1	Awarding institution	Brunel University London
2	Teaching institution	In addition to Brunel University London, add names of any other institutions contributing to the teaching or facilities for students.
6	Final award(s) and FHEQ level of award	<p>Where there is a sandwich programme an award title for the full-time and sandwich awards eg BA(Hons) <i>award title</i> must be identified.</p> <p>Please note that it is not a requirement that the Award title matches the Programme title.</p> <p>FHEQ Level of Award: L7 for Masters-level awards including MEng awards.</p> <p>Level 6 Undergraduate Honours awards.</p>
7	Programme title	For example, insert BA/BSc (<i>title</i>) – do not include (Hons) here, as this would indicate the award, rather than the programme title.
9	Normal length of programme (in months) for each mode of study.

This should only be completed for thick sandwich programmes and the section can be deleted where necessary. The specification will need to identify the contribution of the placement to the overall degree (see bottom of Level 2 placement section and bottom of Level 3 section). Delete this wording where necessary.</p> <p>e) Level 3 information will need to stipulate that Level 3 projects are 'Core' (see explanatory notes at beginning of section 25).</p>
