







Medicine MBBS

- Currently teaching our first 2 cohorts of 200+ international students
- 140 international places available for 2024/25 entry
- We hope to open application to home (UK) students shortly
- BMS sits within the well-established College of Health, Medicine & Life Sciences
- 5-year, Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)
- Recognised around the world (but not Singapore)
- Recognised as a primary medical qualification by UK GMC.
- Full GMC approval will be granted once our first cohort graduate.
- MBBS graduates can remain in the UK for a further 2 years for Foundation Year Training.

How to apply

- Applications for 2024 open both directly via our website and through UCAS on 5 September 2023
- There is no preference in the way you apply, but applicants who apply directly will have to be processed through UCAS before you can receive your CAS (this is usually done in the summer)
- We recommend students have an additional £1,300 per month for other expenditure including accommodation, food, socialising, etc
- Tuition fee, 2024 entry £49,395



Minimum Entry Requirements (2024-25)

General entry requirements

- International fee status
- Normally aged 18 by the 24th September 2024
- English language IELTS 7.0 with no less than 7.0 in each subsection
- Satisfactory personal statement
- Satisfactory academic reference, the referee must have known you for a minimum of 6 months



Brunel Medical School's entry requirements

Qualification	A-Levels & IB	University Clinical Aptitude test (UCAT) & GAMSAT
Minimum grade or degree classification already achieved or expected to achieve	 AAB, which must include: Chemistry or Biology and Mathematics or a second science (Chemistry, Biology, Physics) and a third subject (except General Studies) IB 36, which must include: Higher Level 6 in Chemistry or Biology and Higher Level 5 in a second science (Chemistry, Biology, Physics) or Mathematics. 	Applicants scoring in band 4 in the SJT (Situational Judgement Test) are rejected. UCAT is not compulsory, but we recommend that you take it to strengthen your application. GAMSAT
Mathematics	 At least Grade B (5) in Mathematics GCSE (or equivalent) 	
English	 At least Grade C (4) in English Language GCSE (or equivalent e.g. IELTS)
