



## MBBS international entry requirements 2022/23 entry

All students will need to meet our subject criteria. Our subject criteria is study of one subject from Biology or Chemistry, and further study of one of Biology, Chemistry, Maths or Physics. However, we will be flexible in how we assess this subject knowledge and we will look at any relevant completed modules.

If your qualification(s) do not match our A Level equivalent profile, but you have started a degree in a relevant subject and after one or two years could be eligible, then these qualifications will be considered on a case by case basis. We would be looking for a cognate subject to Medicine or for the completed years of your degree to have covered a good amount of relevant modules, and with good grades.
