Once you've decided you want to study at Brunel, simply log into [UCAS Track](#) and add Brunel as your Clearing choice (if you haven't applied through UCAS yet this year, then you will now need to submit your application through UCAS).

UCAS sends Brunel your application

Your full UCAS application will be referred to Brunel for us to review.

- You need to complete a Fee Status Questionnaire (FSQ) - this is to help us determine whether you should be treated as a home or international student for fee paying purposes. If you receive an FSQ, you will also be provided with some guidance about how to complete it

Apply for accommodation and pay your accommodation deposit

Apply for funding or update student finance
