Choose your course and make a Clearing application

You can **apply online** or by calling +44 (0)1895 272 273. Do you have an international advisor? They can assist you with your Clearing application.

Add Brunel as your Clearing choice

Once you've decided you want to study at Brunel, simply log into **UCAS Track** and add Brunel as your Clearing choice. Don't forget if you have an international advisor they can assist with your application.

Brunel receives your full application

Your full application will be referred to Brunel for us to review from UCAS or through your international advisor.

We'll email you if:

- We need further information in order to assess your application

- You need to complete a Fee Status Questionnaire (FSQ) – this is to help us determine whether you should be treated as a home or international student for fee paying purposes. If you receive an FSQ, you will also be provided with some guidance about how to complete it

Apply for accommodation and pay your accommodation deposit

You can select your accommodation and pay your accommodation deposit online - find out more about our **on-campus accommodation**. Don't worry - all first year students are guaranteed accommodation on campus if they have booked and paid the accommodation deposit by 31 August 2020.

Apply for your Visa

If you need a Tier 4 (general) Student Visa to study in the UK, we will provide you with a CAS number which you can use to apply for your Visa. Before we issue you with a CAS, you will be reminded to:

- **Pay your course deposit**
- Upload evidence of the qualifications you have completed on **MyApplications portal**
- Complete a **Length of Study form** (if necessary)
- Apply for your **ATAS certificate** and upload a copy to **MyApplications portal** (if necessary)

Apply for funding in your own country

Complete online registration task 1

This is first stage of **registration**. You'll receive an email when you need to complete this with full details, simply log into **My Applications portal** and complete the registration task assigned to you.

Complete registration task 2 on campus

The second stage of registration takes place on campus. Find out more about **registration** and don't forget to bring all your documents with you - full details will be in your email.
