Study options

As a partner of Brunel University London we look forward to welcoming your students to our campus very soon. There are a range of undergraduate programmes for students to select from, including English language support.

Entry requirements

We accept applications from students who have the following entry criteria:

- Currently enrolled at an overseas university, college or higher education institution and have completed at least one
 year of study.
- Hold a minimum GPA of at least 2.8 or equivalent. Students who do not meet the minimum requirement may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Where English is not the first language, evidence will need to be provided as proof of ability. Our courses typically require an IELTS score of 6.0, but individual programmes may have additional requirements.

How to apply

Students applying via our exchange programme will first need to be nominated by their home institution. Students applying independently through the Study Abroad programme can visit **brunel.ac.uk/brunelglobal/apply** and complete the online application form.

In order for applications to be processed students will need to submit the following supporting documents:

- Academic transcripts
- English language qualification
- Copy of valid passport (or EU identification card if applicable)
- · Letter of recommendation
- Module selection form
- Proof of funds
