

Pronunciation

(1 hour a week for 7 weeks)

Course length

The first five lessons are for the class as a whole. The last two lessons are devoted to 1-1 sessions. For the 1-1s, students record 1 to 2-minute talks related to their fields of study.

Course Aim and Outcomes

Your spoken English can be understood with ease by an international audience.

To do this you will:

- pronounce individual sounds of English more accurately;
- use stress more accurately.

Course Content

The course focuses on high priority areas which include chunking and prominence, word stress, vowel length, commonly confused consonant sounds, and intonation.

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Course Materials

Provided by the teacher. Students are encouraged to give 1 to 2-minute recorded talks related to their fields of study after each lesson so that further individual feedback can be given by the teacher.
