



## Accessibility Statement for our Library catalogue

This is an accessibility statement from Brunel University London.

### Measures to support accessibility

Brunel University London takes the following measures to ensure accessibility of our Library catalogue:

- Include accessibility throughout our internal policies.

### Conformance status

The Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) defines requirements for designers and developers to improve accessibility for people with disabilities. It defines three levels of conformance: Level A, Level AA, and Level AAA. Our Library catalogue is partially conformant with WCAG 2.1 level AA. Partially conformant means that some parts of the content do not fully conform to the accessibility standard.

This website's underlying platform (Sirsi Dynix Enterprise) is certified as being fully conformant with WCAG 2.1 level AA. Customisations that we have introduced over several years may not be fully conformant. We are working to address this by taking measures such as switching on mobile device-friendly features and taking accessibility into account as we develop new functionality.
