Our vision is a world where everyone can choose to reuse wherever they eat, drink and shop.

From a coffee on your commute, to drinking water on the go, or even shopping with less packaging, Refill puts the power to reduce plastic at your fingertips.


Anyone can download the free Refill app to tap into a global network of places to reduce, reuse and refill. With **300,000 Refill stations**, offering refills for water, coffee, food containers and plastic-free shopping, **400,000 app downloads** and **100 million pieces of plastic** avoided to date, we've proven that Refill has the power to create a wave of change and stop plastic pollution at source.

LIFE WITH LESS WASTE, MADE EASY

Refill works by connecting people with locations where they can eat, drink and shop with less waste.

Anyone can download the free app to find local refill stations near them.

Participating businesses simply sign up to the app and put a sticker in their window, alerting passers-by that they're welcome to come on in and get a refill.



CHANGING BEHAVIOUR

Refill is, at it's core, a behaviour change campaign designed to make it easier for people live with less plastic. We initially launched to tackle the monumental issue caused by single-use water bottles. We knew there was a lack of places to fill up for free across the UK, and the British public didn't feel comfortable asking for a refill if they we're making a purchase.

Fast forward a few years and there are now over 30,000 taps on the app, and we've seen a massive change in how people feel about using a reusable bottle and filling up on the go.

But we know the problem is bigger than just plastic bottles which is why we've expanded to connect people to places they can refill their coffee cup, lunch-box and even groceries.



OUR IMPACT

We're not only powering the Refill Revolution and helping to make refill and reuse options more accessible,we're also helping to:

- Tackle plastic pollution and reducing waste,
- · Combat climate change,
- Provide access to safe, clean drinking water
- Empower individuals and communities.







Recycling schemes

- Cup recycling

Within the Konly 1 in 400

cups are recycled



With a significantly low number of cups being recycled, vast amounts are ending up in landfill. So much so, 152,000 tonnes of carbon dioxide is generated each year through landfill. This is equivalent to the same emissions as 33,000 cars on the road.

Take away plastic cups are often lined with plastic in order to prevent leakage. This means the cups cannot be recycled by traditional paper recyclers. Hence, there has been a need for a more environmentally friendly plastic cup solution.



Recycling process

The cups are taken to a specialised reprocessing plant, which there are only three in the UK. Here they seperate the plastic film from the paper, allowing for the materials to be recovered and recycled into new products. The recycled products are produced by Ashortwalk, which is one of the UK's leading companies in turning recycled waste into new products.



Upcycling on campus

Brunel Uni Food does not only encourage recycling but is a avid promoting a circular economy through upcycling. Indeed, through the Simply cups initiative, we have the chance to purchase items which have been created through the recycled cups. This helps us to remain determined to continually improve our recycling targets. So far we have accumulated over 5 benches on the John Crank Garden and 3 seating areas by the river. These symbolise our attitude towards promoting a sustainable future.

You too can do your bit to support simply cups through purchasing items such as the rCup. This is the world first reusable cup made from recycled cups and was the brainchild of the former Dyson designer Dan Dicker and recycling experts including Closed Loop and Nextek. Together, they have created the most reusable cup on the market today!

What can I do to help?

First we encourage both staff and students at Brunel University London to whenever necessary bring their own reusable cups or flasks. One way this can be achieved is through purchasing Mug for Life in any of our campus outlets. These can used to collect your hot drinks, with an additional benefit of 25p off every coffee. Or, alternatively purchasing the rCups online (Brunel University does not sell these).

Additionally, we encourage staff and student to use the simply waste bins for their cups as much as possible rather than the campus general waste and recycling bins. Mug for life is keen on changing public opinion towards recycling and engages in initiative such as The Square Mile challenge. So, be sure to keep up with their story to get involved and play your part!
