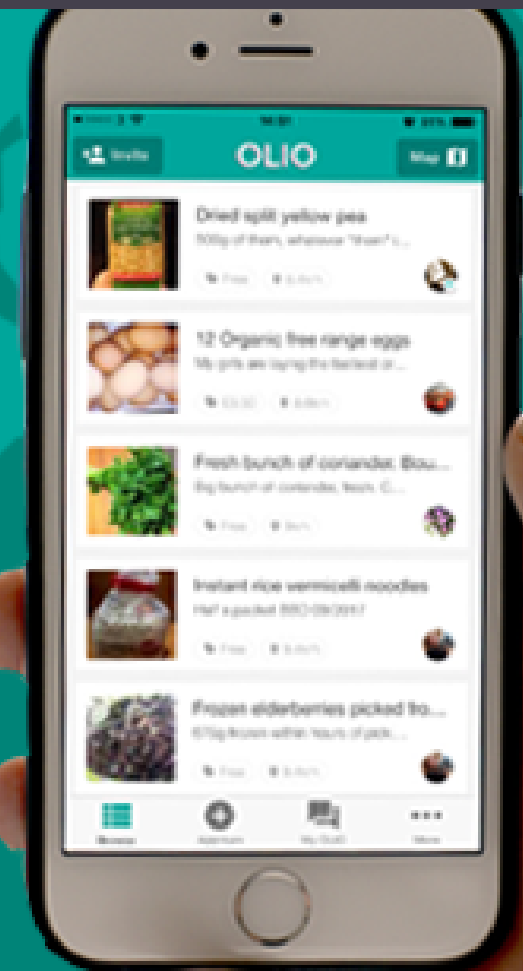
Brunel University is fortunate enough to have the well-known British poet Benjamin Zephaniah, who is also the chair of creative writing at Brunel University.

Feed the world, let them know of OLIO

The most wonderful time of the year has arrived again! Taste Kingdom has joined the OLIO food sharing app, which helps provide food to the local community. From cinema nights to food sharing, our elf's certainly have been busy *spreading Christmas cheer* this December.

Arrival of Olio

Taste Kingdom has now joined the Olio food sharing app. Olio is the app which connects neighbours with each other and local businesses so surplus food can be shared instead of thrown away. We are currently in the process of recruiting our own food waste ambassadors who will help put the food items onto the app. So far during December there has been 24 pickups (neighbour-to-neighbour shares). This is equivalent to 556.2 car miles being taken off the road and 7.5 trees saved per year.

Cinema night - Elf

Our Christmas cinema night showed 'Elf' and provided free mulled wine (alcoholic and non alcoholic), mince pies and popcorn to attendees. This was a huge hit, with many of the viewers staying long after the film had finished.



The cinema nights are a joint collaboration project between; Taste Kingdom, Brunel Residences and Pathway Brunel. The films are shown on the big screen at Brunel Social in The Junction. Free popcorn is provided to all attendees and is usually accompanied alongside other treats.
