Commented [B3]: Your digital footprint is important. Have a LinkedIn profile and an online portfolio of some description to showcase your work

Commented [B4]: A personal summary is an excellent way to give the recruiters, who spend 30 seconds max reading your CV, what they want. It's the best bits of your CV related to the job. Use bullet points and not a bulky paragraph to do this. Think of your key achievements and the outcomes of your actions

Commented [B5]: Active verb led, no I, no narrative. Punchy

Commented [B6]: Relevant, most interesting modules

Commented [B7]: Use a nice plain font like Calibri, Candara, no more than 12 point no less than 10 for the body copy. NOT Times Roman, too depressing

**Commented [B8]:** You're doing a degree course so keep earlier qualifications short and sweet.

Commented [B9]: Most important information first. Most relevant work experience appears first at this stage of your career. Clear sign-posting allows you to do this and play wit chronology. Conventional CVs list the most recent role first, followed by the next etc.

Commented [B10]: Always include date, company and title if possible. Make sure the headings are neatly aligned.

**Commented [B11]:** Hyperlink articles or direct reader to your portfolio

Commented [B12]: Think about how you stand out. Actually landing the work experience can speak volumes

Commented [B13]: Each bullet point leads with an active

Commented [B14]: Your 'day' job can go here unless it's relevant to the role being applied for
